126. “A Celebration of Care” – an arrangement reflecting the NHS & all the other people such as shop workers, veterinary staff, delivery drivers, refuse collectors & care home staff to name but a few, who have supported the country during the Corona Virus Pandemic. The exhibit should incorporate fresh flowers & or foliage. Fruit & vegetables are permitted. Accessories are allowed. Maximum size of 24” overall.
127. “Going to Pot” – an exhibit incorporating fresh flowers and or foliage. Fruit and vegetables are permitted. Accessories are allowed. Maximum size of 24” overall.
128. “Music Maestro Please” an exhibit incorporating a musical instrument of your choice with fresh flowers and or foliage. Fruit and vegetables are permitted. Accessories are allowed. Maximum size of 24” overall.
129. “Mad Hatters Tea Party” – an exhibit incorporating fresh flowers and or or foliage. Fruit and vegetables are permitted. Accessories are allowed. Maximum size of 24” overall.
130. “Some Like It Hot” – an exhibit to incorporate fresh flowers and or foliage. Fruit and vegetables are permitted. Accessories are allowed. Maximum size of 24” overall.
131. “Free Range” – an exhibit incorporating fresh flowers and or foliage, on any subject to be decided by the entrant. Entry to be named. Fruit and vegetables are permitted. Accessories are allowed. Maximum size of 24” overall.

Rules and regulations

AN EXHIBIT – An exhibit is plant material with or without accessories.

ACCESSORY- Anything other than plant material used as part of the exhibit except bases, containers and drapes.

PLANT MATERIAL (FRESH) – All plant material must be living. Driftwood is dried and must not be used in this case.

PLANT MATERIAL (DRIED) – Any dried, preserved or skeletonised plant material including driftwood.

FRUIT & VEGETABLES – Edible and inedible fruit, berries, bulrushes, catkins and cereals are allowed to be used as well as flowers, fruit and vegetables at any stage of their development.

OVERALL – The term used when an exhibit is confined to a given space – 12” overall suggests an empty cube at this size – width, depth and height.

NO ARTIFICIAL PLANT MATERIAL SHALL BE USED EXCEPT WHERE STATED IN THE SCHEDULE.

ARTIFICIALLY COLOURED MATERIAL MAY BE USED UNLESS, OTHERWISE STATED IN THE SCHEDULE.
